


TRAIN DAY 1



Board Rocky Mountaineer in the urban oasis of Vancouver, British Columbia, and journey through the fertile farmlands of the Fraser Valley. Watch as the landscape transforms into the towering peaks of the Coast Mountains. You'll see the mighty Fraser River and the whitewater of Hell's Gate. Soon, the scenery undergoes another dramatic shift and you'll find yourself amid a desert-like landscape peppered with sagebrush. The day's journey comes to a stop in the city of Kamloops, where you will overnight at a hotel.

TRAIN DAY 2



After spending the night in charming Kamloops, you will board the train and follow the North Thompson River, slowing to take in the 91.5-metre (300 ft.) cascade of Pyramid Falls before continuing to Yellowhead Pass. Gliding by teal-green lakes, you'll close in on Mount Robson, the tallest peak in the Canadian Rockies. It's so high that it has its own weather system. This rail route features a succession of spectacular sights, each more impressive than the last. To cap it off, you'll wind up in the picturesque alpine town of Jasper.



You can also choose to travel Westbound, journeying from Jasper to Vancouver.





QUESNEL JASPER

Beginning at the foot of the Coast Mountains, overlooking the modern city of Vancouver, British Columbia, you'll roll along the timeless fjord of Howe Sound. Prepare to be amazed as you make your way past cliffs, canyons, and bridges. You'll arrive at world-famous Whistler, co-host of the 2010 Olympic and Paralympic Winter Games. There, you'll explore the picturesque village and enjoy a relaxing stay at one of Whistler's finest hotels.

The next day, you'll depart from Whistler and travel up the Pemberton Valley, gliding beside gorgeous Anderson and Seton lakes. Turning north and west, the landscape becomes more rugged, with sheer cliffs on one side and milky-green lakes on the other. You'll emerge into the arid ranchland near Quesnel, Canada's gold rush capital. Gold fever may be cured, but there are still many treasures to be found in this historic region.

After an overnight hotel stay in Quesnel, you'll head north again, experiencing mountainous terrain, untouched lakes, and towering waterfalls. You'll gradually gain altitude and enter the Canadian Rocky Mountains. The monumental sight of Mount Robson, the range's highest peak, will greet you as you wind your way to the alpine town of Jasper, Alberta. From awe to elation, every step of the journey is sure to impress.














TRAIN DAY 1



Board Rocky Mountaineer in the scenic city of Denver, Colorado. Before long, you'll be taking in the scenic views of the Gross Reservoir Dam. The train will slowly gain elevation before reaching the Continental Divide, cutting through 10 kilometres (6.2 miles) of mountainous terrain via the Moffat Tunnel. You'll continue along the Colorado River through more rugged landscapes and canyons, including the picturesque Byers and Gore canyons. Keep your eyes peeled for wildlife, as you may get a glimpse of some native to these canyons. You will then pull into Glenwood Springs and relax overnight at a cozy hotel.

TRAIN DAY 2



Your journey begins as you head southwest past mountain vistas and desert cliffs. Impressive landscapes continue as you pass by Parachute Creek and Mount Logan towards De Beque Canyon, a 24-kilometre-long (15 mile) narrow canyon with stair-step cliffs of sedimentary rock layers. Continuing west, you'll pass by Mount Garfield, the highest point of the Book Cliffs. These sandstone cliffs and mountains stretch 320 kilometres (200 miles) from east to west and mark the crossing from Colorado to Utah. Breathtaking red rock formations emerge as you approach Moab, the gateway to Utah's Mighty 5 national parks.





In locations where the top level of accommodation is of a more moderate standard, such as in Kamloops, Quesnel, and Glenwood Springs, the chosen hotels may not be as luxurious as other destinations on your journey, but are still comfortable and inviting.

SPRING APRIL | MAY

As winter relinquishes its hold and the wilderness comes to life, streams swell, bears lumber from hibernation, and flowers start to bloom. This is one of the best times to join us.



SUMMER JUNE | JULY | AUGUST

Warm weather urges vegetation to flourish. Baby animals emerge under their parents' watchful eyes as the days grow longer and the rainforest is at its most lush.



AUTUMN SEPTEMBER | OCTOBER

The forests create a vibrant display of red, orange, and gold, mixed with evergreen. Snow dusts the mountain peaks and animals forage through the wilderness.

ONBOARD THE TRAIN

DO YOU SLEEP ON THE TRAIN?

Our train does not have sleeper cars. You will spend your days on the train and spend your night(s) in a comfortable hotel. This way, you will not miss a moment of the stunning scenery along your journey.

WHAT ARE ROCKY MOUNTAINEER'S HEALTH AND SAFETY PROTOCOLS?

DOES ROCKY MOUNTAINEER STOP FOR PHOTOGRAPHS ALONG THE ROUTE?

No, but the train slows down at particularly scenic locations to ensure you have time for photographs.

HOW DO YOU ASSIGN SEATS?

When you check in, you will receive your pre-assigned seat and overnight accommodation in Kamloops, Whistler and Quesnel, or Glenwood Springs. If you have a special seating request, such as sitting near a friend who has booked separately, please advise us at least 45 days in advance. Please note: we are unable to accommodate specific seat or coach requests.

WILL THERE BE A RANGE OF CULINARY OPTIONS **AVAILABLE TO MEET DIETARY REQUIREMENTS?**

Our onboard menu will have a selection of options to cater to various tastes and requirements. If you have a specific dietary requirement. either an allergy or restriction, please inform us directly or through your travel professional at least 60 days prior to the train departure.

CAN CHILDREN TRAVEL ON ROCKY MOUNTAINEER?

Yes; however, depending on the rail route, a day onboard the train can be up to nine hours, which may be long for some children, and is not recommended for infants.

HOW FAR DO I TRAVEL ON ROCKY MOUNTAINEER **RAIL ROUTES?**

First Passage to the West—about 955 kilometres (595 miles), Journey through the Clouds—about 900 kilometres (560 miles), Rainforest to Gold Rush—about 1,153 kilometres (717 miles), and Rockies to the Red Rocks—about 610 kilometres (379 miles). All journeys travel in daylight.

WHAT IS THE PROTOCOL CONCERNING GRATUITIES?

Onboard train gratuities are included in prices. Gratuities are not included for driver guides, tour escorts, or hotel porterage. If you are travelling on an organized tour, you may want to check with your Tour Director to confirm if gratuities have been included in your tour itinerary.

AM I ABLE TO MOVE AROUND ONBOARD **ROCKY MOUNTAINEER?**

One of the advantages of train travel is the spacious room afforded to all guests. We allow safe movement through your own coach, including an outdoor viewing area to enjoy fresh air, that is accessible only to quests in your coach.

AM I ABLE TO BRING MY PET ALONG?

All pets or animals (excluding qualified service animals) are prohibited from travelling onboard Rocky Mountaineer. If you wish to travel with your service animal, please notify your Vacation Consultant or travel professional at the time of booking, or a minimum of 60 days prior to commencing travel with Rocky Mountaineer.

ARE MEALS INCLUDED?

Meals that are included as a part of your itinerary will be noted with either B (Breakfast), L (Lunch), D (Dinner) on each package page.

WHAT WILDLIFE WILL I SEE?

There are wonderful opportunities for viewing wildlife on all our rail routes, and in our destinations. On any of our rail routes, you may see bear, elk, deer, moose, bald eagles, osprey, salmon, mountain goats, and bighorn sheep. Sightings are never guaranteed. If you do encounter animals, please act responsibly, maintain a safe distance, and never feed any wild animal.

IS TRAVELLING EASTBOUND BETTER THAN WESTBOUND?

Our rail routes are spectacular in either direction and will include the same highlights and scenery. We encourage guests to choose the direction of travel based on their own schedule requirements and availability at the time of booking.
